

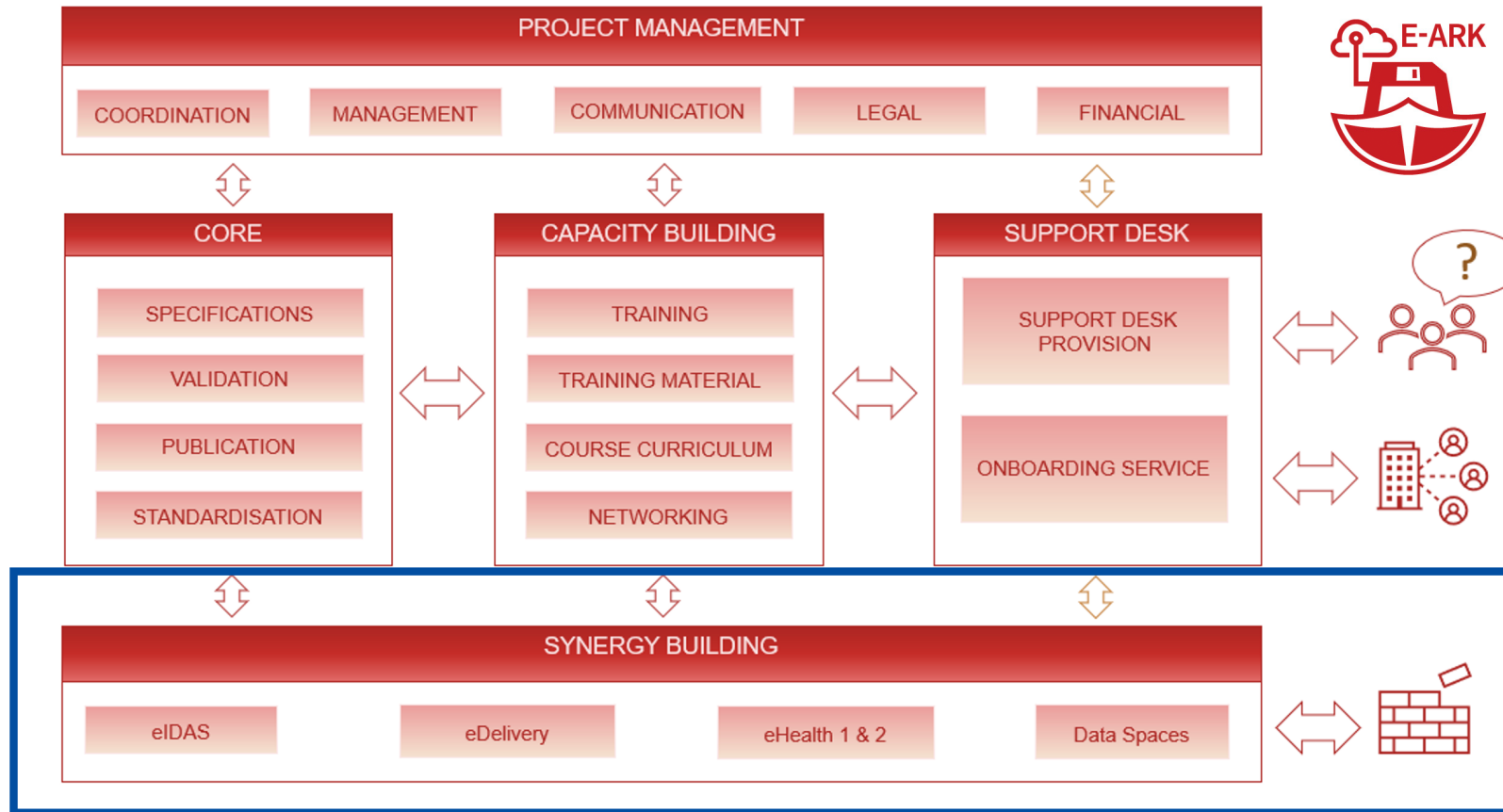

- To elaborate, through consensus, a European approach to the subject matter

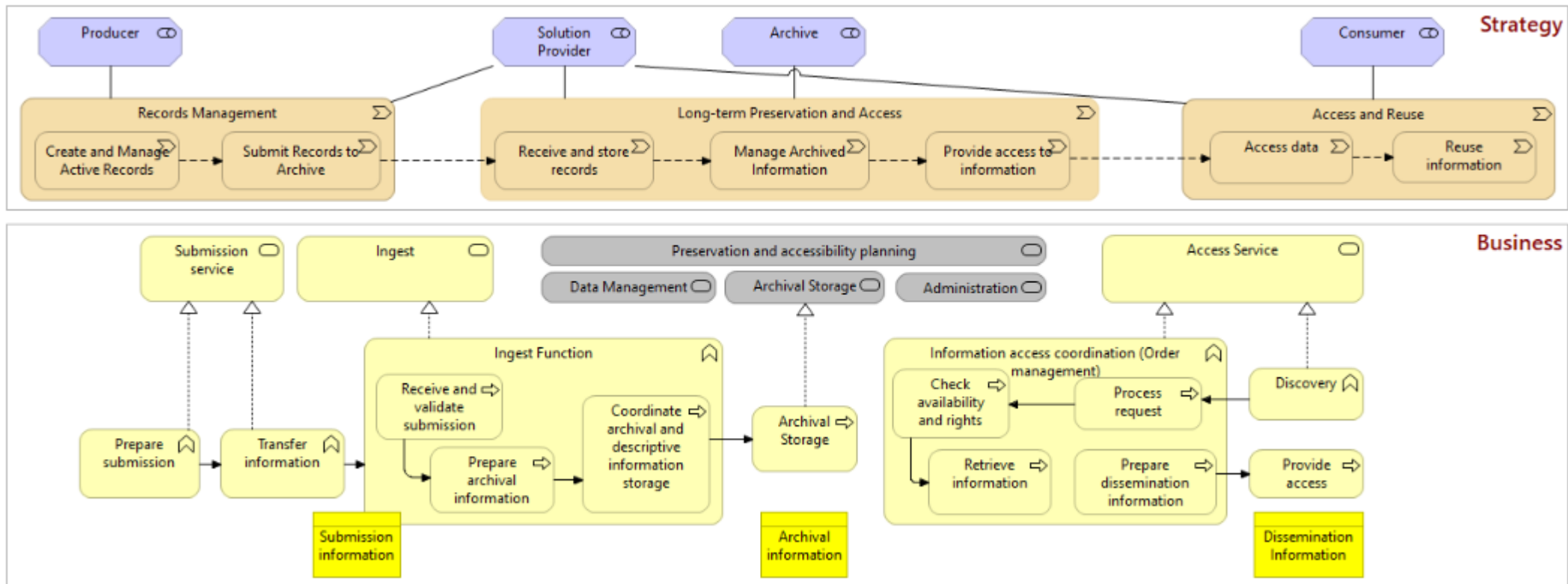


Goal
