

Aim of the eHealth2 specifications and guidelines

To support maintenance of the cancer burden data and their (re)use



Preserve

Retention of cancer burden data that reflects the introduction of new treatment methods and influences changes in health policies



Trust

Clear and easily verifiable cancer burden related data



Usability

Specifications and guidelines can be used for all types of data exports from cancer registries

Information package includes all key elements that end users may need









eHealth2 Specifications in the eArchiving Framework


